Community Action Partnership of Mercer County (CAPMC) is presenting you with a Request For Proposal (RFP) opportunity to administer, manage and operate the largest Early Education Program in Mercer County, PA.

CAPMC is seeking a sub-recipient who will provide Early Education Services to 559 eligible children ages 0-4 and their families in Mercer County for the period of July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2028 and who will assume employment of 124 current staff persons most of whom are subject to a bargaining unit agreement.

The services are funded by two federal grants from the Administration for Children and Families for Head Start and Early Head Start and two state grants from the Office of Child Development and Early Learning for the Head Start Supplemental Assistance Program and the Pre-K Counts Program.

The sub-recipient will operate the programs while the recipient CAPMC will manage the finances.

Letters of Intent are due on September 1, 2023, and proposals are due on October 27, 2023.
